

Grub Worm Control



White grubs are the larval stage of a number of different types of scarab beetles. While adults don't bother turfgrass much, the damage to lawns comes while in the larvae form underground. They appear as C-shaped white grubs with six legs located by their head.

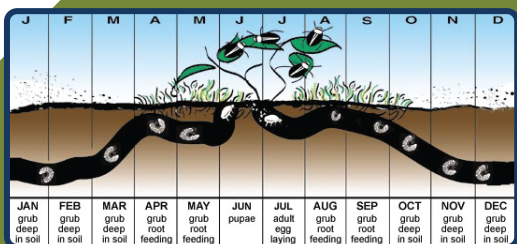

Signs of Damage

Dying or a damaged area of grass may be caused by grub worms. Since the root system and plant bed has become weaker, grass may feel spongy or easy to lift up like a piece of carpet.

White Grub Worm Treatment

Best controlled with active ingredients Trichlorfon, Chlorantraniliprole or Imidacloprid.
